


Brockley: **Then & Now**

Our inspiration We found this remarkable photograph in the Brockley Society archives: a massive group portrait of the men, women and children who gathered on Hilly Fields, Brockley, in August 1918 after a procession commemorating the start of the First World War.

The project Inspired by this photograph we plan to make a new one, inviting anyone who lives in or feels any connection with Brockley. The community response has already been amazingly enthusiastic and we expect thousands to participate.

For this contemporary portrait of the people of Brockley we have commissioned the photographer Simon Terrill, widely recognised for his work with large-scale community gatherings. Recent art projects include Bow Cross in East London and Balfron Project in Poplar.

About us Brockley Society is a vibrant community association in the London borough of Lewisham, founded by local residents in 1974 to conserve the area's uniquely preserved Victorian architecture and to promote community activity. Its largest annual event, Hilly Fields Midsummer Fayre, has run for forty-one years and last year attracted an estimated 6,000 people. Our free newsletter is distributed three times a year to 4,000 homes.

Brockley Society is a charity run entirely by volunteers and is financed through the Fayre. It receives no grants except for occasional specific projects.
